## \* Introduction to soil pollution \*

Industry being a voracious consumer of natural resources brought in pollution of air, water & soil environment. Soil pollution usually originates from the development of industry, intensive agriculture associated with modern system of cultivation like use of high analysis chemical fertilizers, use of pesticides, use of sewage, sludge, city composts & other industrial wastes etc.

The contaminants produced by industrial processes reach the soil by three ways:

- a) Through the air, gaseous & particulate contaminants are emitted from chimneys & exhausts or are deflated from spoil heaps & are blown away by the wind ultimately to sink or be washed by rain to the soil environment.
